




Decorated Garden Bags	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White paper lunch bags (100 pack) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • instead of gluing white paper to brown bags, kids can draw directly onto the white lunch bags <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Squash, B2, p. 11 • Zucchini 	27
Garden Bookmarks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White cardstock, 8.5x11 (250 pack) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Instead of 9x3" strips, cut the 8.5x11 sheets into four strips that are 2.75" width by 11" length. See below. <div style="text-align: center; margin: 10px 0;">  </div> <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Squash, A2, p.5 • Spinach A1, p.3 • Cantaloupe, A1, p. 3 • Zucchini 	28
Produce Placemats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11" x 17" cardstock (200 pack) <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sweet Potato, B3 p. 13 • Strawberries, B1 p. 9 • Zucchini 	29
Garden Scene Note Cards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5x7 blank white notecards with envelopes (packs of 50) • Labels (2.625 x 1") with "This Card Handmade by" (sheets of 30 labels) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write the child's name on the label and stick on the back of the card <div style="text-align: center; margin: 10px 0;">  </div> <p>VARIATIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Squash, B3 p. 13 • Cantaloupe, B1 p. 9 • Zucchini 	30
Tasty Acres Mobile	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4" cardboard circle cutouts 	31

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • instead of cutting circles from construction paper • Plastic hangers (pack of 45) • Roll of string, 656 ft per roll <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sweet Potato, C1, p. 15 	
Stamped Wrapping Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cucumber, spinach leaves, or oranges (see examples below on how to cut the fruit/vegetable beforehand) • White butcher paper, 18 inch x 350 ft • Acrylic paint set (2 sets per classroom) • Use set of knives that were delivered to each classroom at the beginning of the summer with the strawberry unit <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">   </div> <p style="font-size: small; margin-top: 5px;">This is a creative way to gift wrap a present. This gift wrapping paper is made from potato pieces. You can cut the potato into different shapes and then use various colors to stamp it onto paper.</p> <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spinach A2, p.5 • Cucumber • Oranges 	32
Row Markers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5x7" white backing board (100 pack) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Instead of 2- by 4-inch rectangles of corrugated cardboard and 4- by 6-inch pieces of white paper (kids can draw directly onto the white backing board) • Wooden craft sticks (200 pack) • Clear packing tape on a dispenser (2 rolls) • All three of these items will be delivered at beginning of the summer along with Strawberry unit materials <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strawberries, B2 p. 10 • Cucumber • Zucchini 	33
Seed Art	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Seed blend, 8 lb bag • White 8x10" cardboard pieces (50 pack) • Paintbrushes (set of 50) – for pasting white glue onto cardboard pieces <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sweet potato B1, p. 9 • Peaches, A2 p. 4 • Oranges 	34
Painted Pots	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6-inch terra-cotta pots, two per child (one for Peaches unit and one for Oranges unit) • Acrylic paint (2 sets per classroom; also used for wrapping paper craft) 	35

Garden Stones	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smooth, round stones, 4-inch (sets of 30); one rock per child for each unit (Spinach, Peaches, Cucumber, for a total of 3 rocks per child) • Waterproof non-toxic paint pens, set of 12 (5 per classroom) • Puffy paint (2 sets per classroom) • Can of spray clear shellac to seal and waterproof painted stones, 11 oz can (4 per classroom) <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spinach, B2. P. 11 • Peaches: C1, p. 14 • Cucumber 	36
Garden Gloves	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid-colored gardening gloves, preschool sized (about 60 per classroom – 2 sets per child for both the squash unit and the cantaloupe unit) • Non-toxic fabric pens, set of 32 (5 sets per classroom) <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Squash, B2 p. 9 • Cantaloupe, B2 p. 11 	37
Make a Scarecrow	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two pieces of light-weight wood, approximately 5 feet and 3 feet in length, nailed together • Small bale of hay (1 per classroom) <p>VARIATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Squash, C1 p. 5 • Sweet Potato, C3 p. 15 • Cantaloupe, C1 p. 15 	38
